MATERIALS

DB37202 Margarita Glass
Detail Brush
Fan Brush
Sponge
Pen

COLORS

CMM 86- Pretty In Pink
CMM 31 - Licorice
CMM 22 - Gecko Green
CMM 48 - Guacamole
CMM 7 - Blush
CMM 57 - Squash Blossom
CMM 59 - Turquoise

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Sponge the inside of the glass with 2 coats of the pinks. We dipped our sponge into both Pretty in Pink and Blush allowing the colors to blend together.
2. Sponge the top outside section of the glass with 3 coats of Gecko Green.
3. Dip the flat side of the sponge piece into Guacamole and tap on a few messy columns to create the stripes on the green of the watermelon.
4. Use a detail brush in Licorice paint and add a few seeds ton the inside.
5. Paint the rest of the outside with 3 coats of your desired colors. We did Squash Blossom for an orange glass and Turquoise for the blue glass.

TIPS

- When using a detail brush, the harder you press on the brush the heavier the lines will be.
- Allow both pinks to blend when sponging the inside.
